The merchant was Marcellus Jones. The ledger, dating from 1835-1836, documents the types of goods purchased by residents and include tobacco, coffee, boots, postage and sugar. A notation "Negro" is also included if the customer is African American. The Nabb Center has the original ledger (accession #2001.010) that was donated to the Nabb Center by a community member who had purchased it at a local auction. The transcription was done by a Nabb volunteer.

The transcriber also created an index of the names of the customers and an abstract of the information done in a spreadsheet that allows the researcher to see the business that was conducted. This list of customers is helpful for researchers trying to document the name of someone who dealt at the store during that time period, as well as for seeing the types and prices of merchandise sold at the time.

The town of Whitehaven, located on the Wicomico River across from Mount Vernon, Maryland was established in 1708. It is now a national historic district and is home to the Whitehaven Ferry that has been in continuous operation since at least 1688. The historic Whitehaven Hotel, now a bed and breakfast, and other historic homes are also located in Whitehaven.

#### Somerset Village Herald—Tragic Christmas Day drowning near Long Hill in 1833

I found this notation in the St. Mary's Cemetery section of Shari Handley's "Tyaskin Page" online. This is the same incident that I came across in the Somerset Village Herald—the only local newspaper in 1833—

NOTE: \*\*\* From 12 Jan 1833 newspaper (name unknown): "O12 Jan 1833. On Thursday last, 25 Dec., 3 ladies and 2 young gentlemen, whilst proceeding in a canoe across Wetipquin Creek, the canoe suddenly overturned and 2 of the ladies, and 1 gentleman were drowned, to wit; Mr George L Walter and his sister Ann Maria Walter, only children of the late Col James Walter, and Adeline Jones, eldest daughter of Capt Marcellus Jones. Miss Sarah Jones and Rufus Dashiell were saved. Buried St Mary's Church, Quantico, MD."

The Walter family still lives nearby in Tyaskin. Priscilla Walter today lives at the Turnstile Farm, which is at the head of Wetipquin Creek; I don't know where the Walters lived in 1833, but my guess would be right in the vicinity. The Walter family founds Walterville, which later is renamed Bivalve.

Rufus Dashiell was the son of General Matthias Dashiell, who lived at Long Hill and was buried there in 1835, two years after this incident. Rufus was born in 1818. He dies just two months short of his 21 st birthday in April 1839 in Princess Anne, and was an M.D. and was buried at Long Hill.

Note: I can't be for certain that the incident takes place at Long Hill, however, it involves the Dashiell family, and the Prominent Jones family, and the Walter family.

The New York Enquirer August 20 1832 (from the Fulton County Archives newspaper database) MARYLAND

The Village Herald, printed at Princess Anne, Somerset Co. Maryland states that since the following letter was written, two new cases and one death (a person of color) had occurred at White Haven. Those who, like the unfortunate persons alluded to, allow themselves the indulgence of a hearty meal of crabs at this season, cannot reasonably hope to avoid a similar fate.

Extract of a let to the Editor of the Village Herald, date White Haven, (Somerset Co.) Aug. 12, 1832. Dear Sir—I take up my pen to communicate to you intelligence of the unhappy fate of three persons who have died with the Asiatic Cholera. I say the Asiatic Cholera, because it has been so pronounced by the attending Physicians. A vessel belonging to Catp. Marcellus Jones returned from Baltimore to this place last Thursday. The Captain, Mr. David Conway, was attacked the same evening after his arrival, and died the next morning before the sun had risen. It may be necessary to state that before his attack the eat [sic] a very hearty meal of crabs. I have been informed however, that he complained of being unwell previous to this feast. The general impression seems to be that he acquired the disease in Baltimore, and that his eating the crabs only acted as the exciting cause. The two negroes—one the property of Capt. Jones, and the other of Capt. Jesse Hughes, were attack in a similar manner. They all belonged to the same vessel, and within the space of a few days, though blessed with health and vigorous constitutions, have been numbered with the dead. It is said that the negroes also eat of the crabs, and I have understood that a boy, belonging to the same vessel, who did not participate in the feast, has escaped the dreadful disease. It is deemed necessary to state this face in order that your readers may be in the possession of all the incidents and circumstances to form their conjectures upon— The Physicians, however, are thoroughly impressed with the opinions that it is the Asiatic Cholera. The New York Morning Courier and New York Enquirer, August 20, 1832

Spelling can vary throughout the ledger; by my guess is that there are 3 different clerks at the store. I have used [--] to indicate what the probable standard spelling would be.

Identification Numbers: each person with a regular credit account was given an account number. The complete master list of the account holders and numbers didn't survive. In some cases the customer I.D. number switch.

#### **Marcellus Jones' Store Burns:**

1828 January 23 (evening) On the 19<sup>th</sup> inst.; the store house and goods of Marcellus jones, of Whitehaven, Eastern Shore of Maryland, were consumed by fire; the loss is estimated at near \$7,000.
